









































Earth features - brown

Linear earth banks, gullies etc may be used on White and Yellow courses both to navigate by (known as "handrails") and as control points.

Point features such as knolls and depressions are only used as control points on Orange courses and upwards.

Rock features - black

Point features such as crags and boulders are only used as control points on Orange courses and upwards.

Water features - blue

Linear streams and ditches may be used on White and Yellow courses both to navigate by (known as "handrails") and as control points.

Point features such as ponds are only used as control points on Orange courses and upwards.

Vegetation

The darker the green, the thicker the vegetation and the harder it is to get through.

Distinct vegetation boundaries may be used on White and Yellow courses both to navigate by (known as "handrails") and as control points.

Manmade features - black

Linear features such as tracks, paths and fences are used on White and Yellow courses both to navigate by (known as "handrails") and as control points.

Point features such as cairns and buildings are only used on Orange courses and upwards as control features.
